Called to order at 7:01 PM/ via Google Meet

President Dudley announced a quorum had been met. The members present are listed at the bottom on the Minutes.

Treasurer’s budget amendments were announced to the Membership as follows: amend to reflect actual balance; add line item to receive \$5,000 from National PTA; add expense line item for Pantry Grant expenses; scholarships \$1,200 (4 @ \$300).

Kim House moved to approve the Board’s amendments. Peggy Lloyd seconded. No questions were raised. The vote passed unanimously.

Beth Zeinert moved to make Tax Free Day Oct. 17th. Peggy Lloyd seconded. No questions were raised. The vote passed unanimously.

The Financial Reconciliation Committee reviewed all records and did not have any recommendations. The Board recommended we adopt the Committee’s report. Betsy Clark motioned to approve the report. Frank Mbah seconded. No questions were raised. The vote passed unanimously.

President Dudley announced that we were awarded a \$5,000 National PTA grant, and discussed how it was being used to fund the Pantry with our partners. President Dudley reminded the members of our upcoming Yard Sale and Reflections contest. The members were informed about the traditional programs. Corporate sponsors were thanked. Members were reminded of passive fundraising opportunities.
